# East Piney Island Community Association (EPICA) Annual Report, Chincoteague Island, Virginia, October 1, 2022



Dear East Piney Island Property Owner,

Again, this year the EPICA October Annual Meeting will be virtual, considering the on-going Covid 19 threat.

### The following text documents our current status:

#### Treasurer's Report:

EPICA Board Treasurer Greg Balasus' 2022 Annual Report shows where we are financially.

- EPICA has received **54 dues payments** (\$200 for a house and \$100 for a vacant lot) (47% participation rate) **totaling** \$11,900.00.
- **Total paid to vendors is \$8,892.00**. Almost all the funds were expended for roads upkeep. In addition, there were small outlays for our P.O. Box, Website hosting and the annual non-profit organization registration fee to the State of Virginia.
- The **remaining balance** in EPICA's account at PNC Bank on Chincoteague is \$10,504.00.

By comparison: There were 48 dues payments in 2021 for a total of \$10,700.00.

Although 2022 is a mild improvement over 2021, in order to pay road repairs in both the fall and spring, we need a meaningful increase in community participation. Simple math is roughly \$18,000 to do repairs twice per year and we are collecting less than \$12,000. At this point the roads will have to remain as is until the spring.

We do not plan to do fall road work as it is not necessary and we do not have the funds. We did have some reports of increase in dust, but it was a dry summer and there was much fast moving summer visitor traffic.
